The winery offers pinot noir as well as small amounts of pinot gris, pinot blanc and chardonnay. The wines are produced from our three estate vineyards — Foley Family Estate, Doe Ridge Estate, Weathergage Estate and other top sites in the Willamette Valley. Highly acclaimed, The Four Graces wines are hand-crafted in small lots using traditional techniques coupled with the most modern technology in winemaking.



VINTAGE

The 2021 vintage will be remembered in the Willamette Valley for record setting heat and dry conditions. The pinot noir for this rose was harvested from two late-ripening vineyards in the Willamette Valley on the same day: September 10th. This relatively early picking date assured the rosé was lower in alcohol and retained the grape's natural acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Our 2021 Rosé of Pinot Noir is a beautiful light pink color with a touch of rouge. Delicate aromas of ripe cherry, strawberry and a hint of lime zest set the tone for this delightful rosé. The palate shows bright notes of wild strawberry and watermelon that lead into a soft minerality. A lively acidity accents the ripe fruit flavors and carries the wine into a tart, crisp finish. A perfect pairing for warm afternoons, summer salads and lightly seared tuna.
